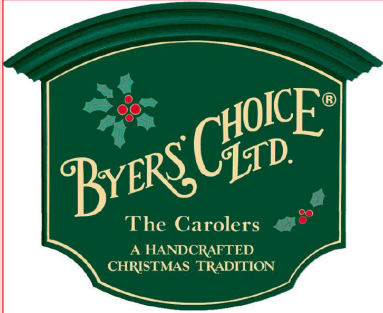
Easily Set The Mood

The month of May is a great time to see all of the brand new *Byers' Choice* introductions! But this year, we've added an even special twist to the month!

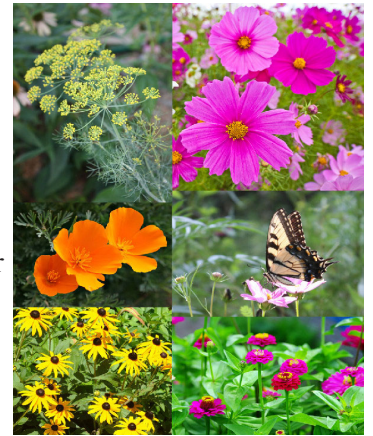

Rowe Pottery Is Back!

We're proud to be able to re-introduce a wonderfully functional and collectible line of salt glaze pottery.

The craftsmanship behind *Rowe Pottery* is the same as it was back in the 1800's. Potters carefully craft each piece on the wheel; artists then decorate each pot with the same cobalt blue patterns; and finally each pot is stacked high atop one another and loaded into an awaiting 2000 degree kiln. As the clay begins to melt and fuse, salt is placed in the path of the flames. The salt explodes into vapor forming a durable, permanent glaze. Since all of the products are handmade, each piece varies slightly in size and shape and is personally signed by each crafter.

The popularity of this product has spanned decades, and we're glad to once again offer it in Dixboro!

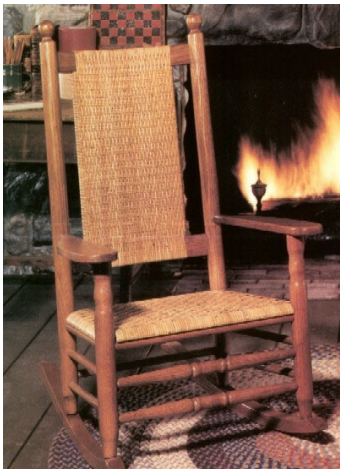

The original **Kennedy Rocker** is back! The rocker that traveled the country on Air Force One, and took up residency in the White House, is once again being made, (after being unavailable for a couple of years). We're happy to say we just received our first batch!

As a young U.S. senator from Massachusetts, John Kennedy went to see a Dr. Travell about recurring back pain from injuries suffered in World War II. Kennedy had undergone spinal surgery the year before but was still in excruciating pain. During his first visit to Travell's office, Kennedy first sat in the rocker. The doctor had seen the oak and rattan rocker in a trade publication and ordered them for some of her patients. When Kennedy left, he said he

wanted to buy that exact same chair!

In fact, he would go on to buy dozens of them. He had them in several rooms, and would always have some on hand for gifts. You'll find many photos in history books of JFK sitting in that rocker making some very important decisions.
